

**UPDATED SUMMARY
HOUSE BILL 14-1329**

Second Regular Session - Sixty-ninth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

Section 1 of the bill defines terms.

Sections 2 and 3 deregulate the following services:

- ! Advanced features offered and provided to residential customers and nonresidential customers with no more than 5 lines;
- ! Premium services;
- ! InterLATA toll, *except with respect to interexchange carrier registration, complaints of unauthorized charges on a subscriber's bill, or complaints of changing a subscriber's service without his or her consent;*
- ! IntraLATA toll, *except with respect to interexchange carrier registration, complaints of unauthorized charges on a subscriber's bill, or complaints of changing a subscriber's service without his or her consent;*
- ! Private line service with a capacity of less than 24 voice grade circuits;
- ! Nonoptional operator services;
- ! Internet-protocol-enabled services; and
- ! Voice-over-internet protocol services.

Section 4 of the bill appropriates \$21,220 and 0.3 FTE to the public utilities commission and \$18,216 to the department of law for implementation of the bill's provisions.
