

**UPDATED SUMMARY
SENATE BILL 14-135**

Second Regular Session - Sixty-ninth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

The bill repeals certain provisions concerning the purchase of firearms in states that are contiguous to Colorado.
