## A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF DISTRICT COURT
102	JUDGES IN THE TWELFTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT, AND, IN
103	CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

## **Bill Summary**

Effective July 1, 2015, the bill increases the number of district court judges in the twelfth judicial district from 3 to 4.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	<b>SECTION 1.</b> In Colorado Revised Statutes, 13-5-113, <b>add</b> (2) (c)
3	as follows:
4	13-5-113. Twelfth district. (2) (c) Subject to available
5	APPROPRIATIONS, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015, THE NUMBER OF JUDGES FOR
6	THE TWELFTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT SHALL BE FOUR.
7	<b>SECTION 2.</b> Appropriation. (1) For the 2015-16 state fiscal
8	year, \$340,651 is appropriated to the judicial department. This
9	appropriation consists of \$333,631 from the general fund and \$7,020
10	from the judicial department information technology cash fund created in
11	section 13-32-114 (1), C.R.S. To implement this act, the department may
12	use this appropriation as follows:
13	(a) \$94,170, which consists of \$87,150 from general fund and
14	\$7,020 from the judicial department information technology cash fund,
15	for courthouse capital and infrastructure maintenance; and
16	(b) \$246,481 from the general fund for trial court programs, which
17	amount is based on an assumption that the department will require an
18	additional 3.2 FTE.
19	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
20	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
21	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
