## **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

#### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$340,651 to the Judicial Department for FY 2015-16, including \$333,631 from the General Fund and \$7,020 cash funds from the Judicial Department Information Technology Cash Fund. The appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 3.2 FTE.

#### **Points to Consider**

#### General Fund Impact

The general appropriations bill for FY 2015-16 has not yet been introduced. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$333,631 for FY 2015-16, reducing the amount of General Fund available for other existing programs.
