

**UPDATED SUMMARY
HOUSE BILL 16-1341**

Second Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

The bill prohibits the sale, purchase, trade, or distribution (sale) of any covered animal species part or product, with limited exceptions. *The provisions of the bill do not apply to any gun, knife, or musical instrument.* ~~including exceptions for certain antiques, guns and knives, and musical instruments.~~ The bill establishes an unclassified misdemeanor for a first offense and an unclassified felony for second and subsequent offenses, both punishable with monetary penalties.

Colorado wildlife officers and other commissioned officers of the division of wildlife ~~are responsible for enforcing the~~ *may enforce* provisions of the bill.
