

**UPDATED SUMMARY  
HOUSE BILL 16-1211**

**Second Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly**

*This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.*

The bill creates a retail marijuana transporter license and a medical marijuana transporter license. The license is valid for ~~5~~ 3 years. A licensed marijuana transporter (transporter) provides logistics, distribution, and storage of marijuana and marijuana products. A transporter may contract with multiple businesses. ~~and may also hold another marijuana license.~~ A transporter must be licensed by ~~December 31, July 1, 2017,~~ in order to continue to operate. *The state licensing authority shall begin taking applications on January 1, 2017. The bill gives the state licensing authority rule-making authority for transporter licensed businesses, including requirements for drivers, including obtaining and maintaining a valid Colorado driver's license; insurance requirements; acceptable time frames for transport, storage, and delivery; requirements for transport vehicles; and requirements for licensed premises.* ~~The bill describes the circumstances under which a business can terminate a contract with a transporter.~~
