101      **CONCERNING A MODIFICATION TO THE EXEMPTION FROM THE**

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-47-106, **amend**  
3 (2) (a) as follows:

4 **12-47-106. Exemptions.** (2) (a) NOTWITHSTANDING any  
5 provision of this article or article 46 of this title to the contrary,  
6 ~~notwithstanding~~, when permitted by federal law and rules and regulations  
7 promulgated pursuant thereto, ~~a head of a family~~ AN ADULT may produce,  
8 for ~~family~~ PERSONAL use and not for sale, ~~such~~ AN amount of fermented  
9 malt beverage or malt or vinous liquor ~~as~~ EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT THAT  
10 is exempt from the federal excise tax on ~~such~~ THE alcohol beverage when  
11 produced by ~~a head of a family~~ AN ADULT for ~~family~~ PERSONAL use and  
12 not for sale.

13 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
14 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
15 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
