104 **WILDLIFE.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

If allowed pursuant to federal law, exempts licenses issued by the division of wildlife in the department of natural resources from the requirement that licensing agencies require license applicants to submit their social security numbers for purposes of enforcing the applicants' child support obligations.

Capital letters indicate new material to be added to existing statute.

Dashes through the words indicate deletions from existing statute.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 26-13-126 (4), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
3 amended to read:

4 **26-13-126. Authority to deny, suspend, or revoke professional,**
5 **occupational, and recreational licenses.** (4) **SUBJECT TO SECTION**
6 **24-33-110 (1), C.R.S.,** for purposes of this section, "license" means any
7 recognition, authority, or permission that the state or any principal
8 department of the state or an agent of such department is authorized by
9 law to issue for an individual to practice a profession or occupation or for
10 an individual to participate in any recreational activity. "License" may
11 include, but is not necessarily limited to, any license, certificate,
12 certification, letter of authorization, or registration issued for an
13 individual to practice a profession or occupation or for an individual to
14 participate in any recreational activity.

15 **SECTION 2.** 24-33-110 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
16 amended to read:

17 **24-33-110. Applications for licenses - authority to suspend**
18 **licenses - rules.** (1) Every application by an individual for a license
19 issued by the department of natural resources or any authorized agent of
20 such department shall require the applicant's name, address, and social
21 security number; EXCEPT THAT _____ THE DIVISION OF WILDLIFE SHALL
22 NOT COLLECT APPLICANTS' SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER ON LICENSE
23 APPLICATIONS UNLESS REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW. NO LICENSE ISSUED
24 BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES OR ANY AUTHORIZED AGENT
25 OF SUCH DEPARTMENT SHALL DISPLAY THE HOLDER'S SOCIAL SECURITY
26 NUMBER.

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SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,

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determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate

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preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
