**TITLE:** CONCERNING CLARIFICATIONS TO THE REQUIREMENT OF OBTAINING A CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK PRIOR TO THE TRANSFER OF A FIREARM AT A GUN SHOW.

### **Summary of Assessment**

This bill clarifies statutes governing requirements for obtaining a criminal background check prior to the transfer of a firearm at a gun show. The bill also repeals the definition of "collection" and clarifies the definition of "gun show". The bill will become effective July 1, 2004.

These clarification do not substantively affect a gun show vendor's responsibilities, or the likelihood that the background check provisions will be violated. This bill is not anticipated to affect state or local government revenue or expenditures, and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
