**Summary of Legislation**

This bill maintains the requirement for each county sheriff to maintain a list of the persons to whom permits have been issued to carry a concealed handgun, but prohibits law enforcement agencies from maintaining a statewide concealed handgun permit database. The bill changes the date from July 1, 2007, to July 1, 2004, after which a sheriff shall not share information from the list of permittees with a law enforcement agency for the purpose of creating a statewide database. The bill further requires any information concerning a permittee that is included in such a database to be removed from the database no later than July 1, 2004, rather than July 1, 2007.

**Local Government Impact**

This bill will eliminate any costs that law enforcement agencies may have incurred to maintain and administer the statewide database, but may increase administrative costs to communicate with other local and state agencies regarding permits issued in each agency's jurisdiction.

**State Appropriations**

No new state appropriations will be required for FY 2004-05.
