A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING PROHIBITION OF A STATEWIDE CONCEALED HANDGUN**
102 **PERMIT DATABASE.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Prohibits law enforcement agencies from maintaining a statewide concealed handgun permit database.

2 **SECTION 1.** 18-12-206 (3), Colorado Revised Statutes, is

2 **18-12-206. Sheriff - issuance or denial of permits - report.**

3 (3) (a) Each sheriff shall maintain a list of the persons to whom he or she
4 issues permits pursuant to this part 2. Upon request by another criminal
5 justice agency for law enforcement purposes, the sheriff may, at his or
6 her discretion, share information from the list of permittees with a law
7 enforcement agency for the purpose of determining the validity of a
8 permit. ~~A database maintained pursuant to this subsection (3) and any
9 database operated by a state agency that includes permittees shall be
10 searchable only by name.~~

11 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (a) of this
12 subsection (3), on and after July 1, ~~2007~~ 2004, a sheriff shall not share
13 information from the list of permittees with a law enforcement agency for
14 the purpose of creating a statewide database of permittees, and any law
15 enforcement agency that receives information concerning permittees from
16 a sheriff shall not use the information to create or maintain a statewide
17 database of permittees. Any information concerning a permittee that is
18 included in a statewide database pursuant to paragraph (a) of this
19 subsection (3) shall be removed from the database no later than July 1,

21 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
22 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
23 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
