A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING PEACE OFFICER AUTHORITY IN COLORADO FOR CERTAIN
102 FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Provides federal bureau of investigation and United States bureau of alcohol, tobacco, firearms, and explosives special agents with limited peace officer authority in Colorado.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

1	SECTION 1. Part 1 of article 2.5 of title 16, Colorado Revised
2	Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to

4	16-2.5-147. Federal special agents. (1) A SPECIAL AGENT OF
5	THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION OR THE UNITED \boldsymbol{S} TATES BUREAU
6	OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, FIREARMS, AND EXPLOSIVES, IN ANY JURISDICTION
7	WITHIN THE STATE OF COLORADO, IS A PEACE OFFICER WHOSE AUTHORITY
8	IS LIMITED AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION. SAID SPECIAL AGENT IS
9	AUTHORIZED TO ACT IN THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:
10	(a) THE AGENT IS:
11	(I) RESPONDING TO A NONFEDERAL FELONY OR MISDEMEANOR
12	THAT HAS BEEN COMMITTED IN THE PRESENCE OF THE SPECIAL AGENT;
13	(II) RESPONDING TO AN EMERGENCY SITUATION IN WHICH THE
14	SPECIAL AGENT HAS PROBABLE CAUSE TO BELIEVE THAT A NONFEDERAL
15	FELONY OR MISDEMEANOR INVOLVING INJURY OR THREAT OF INJURY TO A
16	PERSON OR PROPERTY HAS BEEN, OR IS BEING, COMMITTED, AND
17	IMMEDIATE ACTION IS REQUIRED TO PREVENT ESCAPE, SERIOUS BODILY
18	INJURY, OR DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY;
19	(III) RENDERING ASSISTANCE AT THE REQUEST OF A COLORADO
20	PEACE OFFICER; OR
21	$(IV)\ Effecting \ an \ arrest \ or \ providing \ assistance \ as \ part \ of$
22	A BONA FIDE TASK FORCE OR JOINT INVESTIGATION WITH COLORADO
23	PEACE OFFICERS; AND
24	(b) THE AGENT ACTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES AND
25	REGULATIONS OF HIS OR HER EMPLOYING AGENCY.

1	EXPLOSIVES IS A PERSON WHO IS EMPLOYED BY THE UNITED STATES
2	GOVERNMENT, ASSIGNED TO THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION OR
3	THE UNITED STATES BUREAU OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, FIREARMS, AND
4	EXPLOSIVES, EMPOWERED TO EFFECT AN ARREST WITH OR WITHOUT A
5	WARRANT FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE UNITED STATES CODE, AND
6	AUTHORIZED TO CARRY A FIREARM AND USE DEADLY FORCE IN THE
7	PERFORMANCE OF THE SPECIAL AGENT'S OFFICIAL DUTIES AS A FEDERAL
8	LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.
9	(3) Upon effecting an arrest under the authority of this
10	SECTION, A SPECIAL AGENT OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION
11	OR THE UNITED STATES BUREAU OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, FIREARMS, AND
12	EXPLOSIVES SHALL IMMEDIATELY SURRENDER CUSTODY OF THE ARRESTED
13	INDIVIDUAL TO A COLORADO PEACE OFFICER.
14	(4) This section does not impose liability on or require
15	INDEMNIFICATION BY THE STATE OF COLORADO FOR ANY ACTION
16	PERFORMED UNDER THIS SECTION BY A SPECIAL AGENT OF THE FEDERAL
17	BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION OR THE UNITED STATES BUREAU OF ALCOHOL,
18	TOBACCO, FIREARMS, AND EXPLOSIVES.
19	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
20	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
21	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
