TITLE: CONCERNING PEACE OFFICER AUTHORITY IN COLORADO FOR CERTAIN FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.

Summary of Assessment

This bill grants agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the United States Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives limited peace officer authority in the state. These federal agents shall have the authority to respond to non-federal felonies and misdemeanors, render assistance to state peace officers, and effect an arrest as part of a state law enforcement task force investigation. The state shall not be required to indemnify agents for the performance of these activities. The bill is effective upon the signature of the Governor.

The fiscal note assumes that the limited law enforcement authority granted to federal agents by this bill will not result in an increase in arrests or criminal convictions. As such, this bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
